

Making a podcast in Garageband

To start a recording:

Open up Garageband.




Click on Podcast.



Give it a name to save as.
Save on desktop.
Click create.



Remember to check that
Metronome is turned off.



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
The podcast track is for images.
 The jingles track is for music/jingles.
 Choose the male or female track to record.

Click on record button to start recording.

Click on record button to stop.




To Edit your work:



To split a track, drag the playhead to where you want to split the recording.
 Remember to select the track you want to split.

Click on edit and split.
 Click on the one you don't want and press delete.



To add images:

Open the folder where you want to use the images from.


OR

Use photo booth to take pictures.





Drag the pictures into the podcast track using the playhead.

You can also use the 'add marker' to place the images in the correct spot.



To add Jingles or sound:


Click on the jingles track and the eye.



Drag the sound you want in the jingle track.




You can change the volume of any track using the volume.



Finishing Off:

Listen to your podcast. Remember to bring the playhead to the start of the track.


Send your podcast to iTunes or disk.



Compress Using: MP3 encoder if only recording.

Compress Using: ACC if adding images.

Change the audio Setting: Spoken podcast.




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Posting to Podomatic:

Go to the website.

Click sign up and follow the steps.

Go to My Podcast.

Click on Post an Episode.

Add the title of your podcast.
Add a short description.




Next, select an audio or video clip:

- Upload a file
- Select from your Media Library
- Record using a webcam or microphone
- Transfer from your desktop using FTP (advanced)
- I don't want to select audio or video. [Skip this step](#)

Click Upload a file to put your podcast here.

Remember to use the **Standard uploader**.

Click Upload Media.




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Click select from your Media Library.

If you want to upload a photo do so or simply click I don't want to select a photo.


Next, select a photo for this episode





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
Creating a Link:

When you are on this page, choose the podcast you would like to share.



Click on Permalink.
